GRAFFITI REMOVAL FORM

Help keep Edgewater graffiti-free by authorizing the City to remove graffiti from public right located on your property free of charge! Graffiti not cleaned up quickly breeds more graffiti. The City of Edgewater intends to be proactive with the clean-up of graffiti within public right of way, but must have your permission to clean-up graffiti on your property. By completing this form the City will have your permission to clean-up graffiti as soon as someone reports it or the City finds it. This form will be kept on file until your property is transferred to another owner or you terminate in writing from the Graffiti Removal program.

CHECK BELOW TO ACCEPT FREE GRAFFITI REMOVAL SERVICES OFFERED BY THE CITY OF EDGEWATER

I **authorize** the City of Edgewater (employees or contractors) and any volunteer group approved by the City to attempt to remove unlawful and unwanted graffiti from my property without charge using available methods and equipment (listed in the Graffiti Removal Program Criteria). If you checked above and you currently have unwanted graffiti on your property and would like it removed, please specify the location of the graffiti:

NOTE: When authorizing graffiti removal, the owner or responsible party understands that the City of Edgewater or its contractor does not guarantee the structural or aesthetic soundness of the areas from which graffiti will be removed and that even in the exercise of due care, damage or injury to real or personal property may result from this activity. I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Edgewater, their officers, agents, employees, and servants, from and against any and all claims, liability, expense, including defense costs and legal fees, and claims for damage of any nature whatsoever, including but not limited to bodily injury, death, personal injury, or property damage arising from or connected with the City of Edgewater's graffiti removal activities. This document will remain in




effect until modified or terminated by the property owner, his or her representative, or the City. Notification shall be in writing. I have read the above and understand it.

Graffiti Removal Program

Report Graffiti: If you have graffiti on your property or you see graffiti on a neighbors property please report the location of this vandalism to the Code Enforcement Hotline at 720-459-3297.

Graffiti Process: The following is the process the City of Edgewater takes when a complaint is received:



Graffiti Removal Processes: The City of Edgewater has set up the following processes to clean-up graffiti within the City following the permission of the property owner:

- Wood Fence- City will pressure wash any graffiti found on wood fence materials.
- Painted Siding- City will paint over any siding materials that have been graffiti vandalized.
- Metal Surface- City will paint over any siding materials that have been graffiti vandalized.

Painting: The City will match the color of paint to the nearest primary color. Only the area that has been vandalized will be painted.



Owner Contact: The City of Edgewater will contact the property owner via the email address listed on the form prior to cleaning. Keep in mind that the City of Edgewater has interest in not letting graffiti remain on private property for long and has every intention to clean up as soon as possible.
