

Fall Leaf Pick-Up



The City of Edgewater will be picking up bagged leaves through a few dates this fall, for all City trash and recycling subscribers through Republic Services. Leaf pick-up service helps to prevent flooding and keeps our neighborhood roads safe for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians.

Leaf Pick-up Guidelines:

- *Leaves must be placed in bags.*
- *In order to have bagged leaves picked up, you must be a current subscriber of the City of Edgewater trash and recycling service through Republic Services.*
- *Bagged leaves need to be placed next to your trash receptacles by 7am on the scheduled pick-up dates listed below.*

Leaf Pick-up Dates:

November 13th

November 20th

December 4th



What else can you do with all of those leaves?

- Use leaves around the yard and garden as mulch and compost.

Please do not rake leaves into the street as this causes drainage issues and is illegal within the City limits of Edgewater.

Upcomming Service Date Change for Trash Service

The City of Edgewater has renewed their contract with Republic Services to provide trash and recycling services to the community. In an effort to better service all of the Edgewater customers, the service date will be changed in early January. Currently the service date is Friday and it will be changed to a Thursday pick-up starting January 7, 2016. Recycling will be serviced every other Thursday from this date on. A new calendar will be mailed out to all customers showing new service dates in December.
