## Youth/Adult Programs

Classes, sports programs, and special events for 2016 are already listed on the [www.playedgewater.com](http://www.playedgewater.com) website. Please check out the site for registration and to check out some new programs we have in store for the 2016 season.

We'll have a new youth yoga class that will run for 6 week sessions and will go year round starting in February.
