A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF EDGEWATER AND THE URBAN DRAINAGE AND FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT CONCERNING THE FUNDING OF MAJOR DRAINAGEWAY PLANNING AND FLOOD HAZARD AREA DELINEATION FOR SLOAN'S LAKE DRAINAGEWAY AND TRIBUTARIES

WHEREAS, intergovernmental agreements between political subdivisions of the State of Colorado to provide functions, services and facilities authorized by the Colorado Constitution and statutes are specifically authorized by Section 29-1-203 C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, Section 19.9 of the Edgewater Home Rule Charter further authorizes such agreements, to be approved by resolution of the Edgewater City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Edgewater has previously adopted, as Article 23 of Chapter 16 of the Edgewater Municipal Code, comprehensive flood hazard area regulations for the purpose of protecting people and property from flood hazards (the "Flood Hazard Area Regulations"); and

WHEREAS, the Flood Hazard Area Regulations rely on various maps, studies and reports to determine matters such as base flood elevations, special flood hazard areas, and high versus low hazard areas; and

WHEREAS, periodic study, reporting and mapping is necessary to determine base flood elevations and the locations of hazard areas because changes in the built urban environment over time can have significant impacts on those elevations and hazard areas; and

WHEREAS, the City's Flood Hazard Area Regulations rely on a previous study and report by the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District entitled "Flood Hazard Area Delineation, Sloan's Lake Basin"; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District has proposed to perform a study and report to update the flood hazard area delineation for the Sloan's Lake Basin, and has proposed that the City, along with Jefferson County and the cities of Denver, Lakewood and Wheat Ridge, participate in the costs of such study and report; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is the best interest of the City and reasonably necessary for the safety of its citizens to participate in the costs of preparation of a new flood hazard area study for the Sloan's Lake Basin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWATER THAT:

Section 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Edgewater and the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District, (Agreement No. 15-11.10), a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby approved by the City Council of the City of Edgewater, Colorado.

Section 2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
