



## **BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND APPEALS VACANCY**

Applications are being accepted for one (1) voluntary position on the Board of Adjustment and Appeals Board. This Board consists of five members, appointed by the Mayor. The appointment is for a term expiring on 12/01/2019. Qualifications are as follows:

- Registered elector.
- Resident of the City of Edgewater for at least one (1) year preceding date of appointment.
- Not an elected official, officer, or employee of the City.
- No convictions for embezzlement, bribery, solicitation of bribery, perjury, subornation of perjury, or any offense involving fraud.

The Board of Adjustment and Appeals shall have the power to hear and determine appeals from refusals of building permits, subject to such limitations and requirements as established by *ordinance*.

The Board of Adjustment and Appeals has the power to make exceptions to the terms of the zoning regulations in harmony with their general purpose and intent to authorize variances from the strict application of the zoning regulations in such situations, subject to such limitations as may be set by ordinance.

The Board has such other functions and duties as set forth by ordinance.
