

2015 Spring Clean-Up Event: Monday, May 4th

- Pick-up locations are the same location your trash is collected weekly.
- Items for pick-up must be out by 8:00am the day of pick-up. You will be able to place things out in the alley throughout the weekend for pick-up on Monday.
- Allied Waste will also supply dumpsters at 22nd and Benton for large item drop off on Saturday, May 9th from 9am - 1pm; along with Electronic & Metal recycling.
- If you do not want items discarded, please remove them from the pick-up location.

May. 4th: Alley-way Clean Up.

(Pick-up location will be where your regularly scheduled trash is picked up from)

May. 9th (9am - 1pm): Large Item Dumpster, Electronic & Metal Recycling

Accepted Items (for both clean-up dates):

- *Please bag or bundle all materials.*
- *Do not pack bags or bundles more than fifty (50) pounds.*
- *Please cut all long pieces of material to lengths no longer than four (4) feet.*
- *Make sure items are from the below list of accepted items as items not accepted will be left.*

Type of Materials	Accepted	Not Accepted
Landscape / Yard Materials	Limbs, yard clippings, leaves, wood mulch	Concrete, dirt, large stumps, fertilizers, chemicals, rocks
Construction Materials	Wood, drywall, windows, doors, decking, carpet, flooring	Concrete, bricks, paints/ stains, chemicals
Metal Materials	Small appliances, metal flashing, metal furniture, household metals	Refrigerators, freezers, A/C units, any appliances with freon, lawn mowers
Household Waste	Household trash, furniture, linens, clothes. Televisions can be disposed of at the drop-off only, no pick-up.	Hazardous or bio-hazardous waste, needles, syringes, hot tubs, batteries.
Automotive	Bumpers, auto body panels, seats, upholstery	Tires, car/truck batteries, vehicle fluids, motor oil plastic bottles, windshield glass
