NOTICE OF COORDINATED MAIL BALLOT ELECTION**

Election Date: November 5, 2013

Election Day Election Hours: All sites will be open 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day to receive voted ballots sealed in the completed affidavit envelopes.

Qualification of Persons to Vote in the Election:

- Citizen of the United States.
- Resident of the state of Colorado for at least 22 days (October 14, 2013).
- 18 years of age on the date of the election.
- Registered to vote.

All active registered voters will receive a ballot by mail delivery to the mail address on record approximately 18-22 days before the election. Voters can choose to mail-in their ballot; drop their ballot off at a Voter Service & Polling Center or drop-off location or vote in-person at a Voter Service & Polling Center.

These sites will serve as collection centers where voters may hand deliver their completed mail ballots, which must be sealed in the official return envelopes. Voters can also apply adequate postage to the official return envelope and deliver their ballot to their local post office.

BALLOT CONTENT IS AS FOLLOWS:

Offices Vacant: One Mayoral position (two year term). Three City Council positions (four-year term of office).

Candidates for Mayor: Bonnie McNulty

Candidates for City Council: Janka Flaska, Laura Keegan and Janet Spangenberg.

Ballot Question No. 2A (Vote Yes or No):

As more particularly set forth in Ordinance No. 17-13 of the City of Edgewater, shall the 2008 City of Edgewater Home Rule Charter be amended:

- (1) At Subsections 2.2(3) and 3.4(3), to remove references to the Fire Department from provisions concerning the qualifications of the Mayor and Council members;
- (2) At Section 3.6, concerning vacancies on Council, to define dereliction of duty based upon absences from Council meetings, to adjust the process for applications for appointment to Council, to limit appointments to Council within 180 days after an election to Council member candidates at the last election, to provide the Council members with an option for special election as an alternative to appointment to fill a Council vacancy, and to prohibit Council member appointment to fill a Council member vacancy within ninety (90) days before a regular election;
- (3) At Subsection 6.6(2) to provide greater clarity as to the effective date of ordinances; and
- (4) At Subsection 6.5(7), to mandate the Mayor's signature on the adoption of emergency ordinances?

Ballot Question No. 2B (Vote Yes or No):

As more particularly set forth in Ordinance no. 17-13 of the City of Edgewater, shall the 2008 City of Edgewater Home Rule Charter be amended:

- (1) In the Prefatory Synopsis, to remove the reference to the Fire Department;
- (2) At Subsections 7.1(1), 7.2(3), 11.1(4), 11.6(2), and 11.8(1)(a), and Section 21.19, to remove the references to the Fire Department and/or volunteer firefighters;
- (3) To repeal Sections 10.2 and 21.36, concerning the Fire Department and the definition of "volunteer firefighter," respectively;
- (4) At Section 10.5, to replace references to the "City Treasurer" with references to the "Finance Director;";
- (5) At Subsection 12.2(2), to remove requirement of a date certain by which the City Manager shall present a proposed budget to the Council;
- (6) At Section 21.15, to remove reference to the "Fire Chief" and to replace reference to the "City Treasurer" with reference to the "Finance Director;";
- (7) At Section 12.13 to allow for approval of an emergency appropriation by emergency ordinance;
- (8) At Section 17.1, to provide a new definition of the term "franchise," and at Subsection 17.2(3), to provide clarity as to the granting of franchises;
- (9) At Section 19.4, to broaden the scope of the bonding requirement; and
- (10) At Subsection 19.6(2), to provide clarity as to the disposition of real property obtained through bequest, gift or donation?

Ballot Question No. 2C (Vote Yes or No):

As more particularly set forth in Ordinance no. 17-13 of the City of Edgewater, shall the 2008 City of Edgewater Home Rule Charter be amended:

- (1) At Subsection 6.8(2), concerning adoption of codes by reference, to correct a typographic error;
- (2) At Subsection 7.4(4), concerning conflicts of interest, to correct a typographic error;
- (3) At Section 10.4, concerning the Department of Public Works, to correct a typographic error;
- (4) At Section 12.7, concerning the adoption of the budget by the Council, to make the section compliant with the Taxpayer's Bill of Rights;
- (5) At Section 14.2, concerning revenue securities, to make the section compliant with the Taxpayer's Bill of Rights; and
- (6) At Section 15.5, concerning improvement district securities, to make the section compliant with the Taxpayer's Bill of Rights?
