Edgewater Utility Customer,

There will be some minor changes to utility rates in Edgewater taking effect in 2017. Sewer usage fees will be adjusted on your first utility bill for January mailed in February, 2017. The City of Edgewater is not planning to change water rates for 2017 based on no changes in consumption rates from Denver Water.

How much are rates increasing?

Water & Sewer Usage Increases: Edgewater purchases water from Denver Water then charges Edgewater consumers accordingly. Sewer charges are paid to Metro Waste for the disposal of sewage through the Edgewater system. The 2017 water consumption rates will remain the same and sewer rates will increase by 2% based on increase from Metro Wastewater Reclamation District. These incremental changes in rates are a pass through from our service providers and are programmed into the City of Edgewater's rate structure.
