October 5th

Where: *Your regular trash pickup location*

-Alley-way Clean up.

Pick-up will be the location of your regularly scheduled trash pick-up. Items for pick-up must be out by 8:00am the day of pick-up. You will be able to place things out in the alley throughout the weekend for pick-up on Monday. Please read the rules below for pick-up.

Where: *20th and Depew Parking Lot*

Please make sure to have a Edgewater addressed picture ID or a Edgewater utility bill with a picture ID for entrance into the clean-up location.

-Large Item Dumpster

-Electronic and Metal Recycling

-Paper shredding (Edgewater Residents Only)

All American Records Management will have their mobile shred truck parked at 20th and Depew. All American Records Management will be accepting copy machine paper, letterhead, white tablet paper, computer printout paper, laser print paper, typing paper, miscellaneous white paper, staples and paper clips are fine. We cannot shred plastics, VHS tapes, CD's binders, or thermal paper. Please note there will be a 2-3 box maximum per person for this event. For your security please wait for your turn in line without dropping off items.



Accepted Items (for both clean-up dates)

- All materials must be bagged or bundled.
- Do not pack bags or bundles more than fifty (50) pounds.
- Please cut all long pieces of material to lengths no longer than four (4) feet.
- Make sure items are from the below list of accepted items as items not accepted will be left.

Type of Materials	Accepted	Not Accepted
Landscape/Yard Materials	Limbs, yard clippings, leaves, wood mulch	Concrete, dirt, large stumps, fertilizers, chemicals, rocks
Construction Materials	Wood, drywall, windows, doors, decking, carpet, flooring	Concrete, bricks, paints/ stains, chemicals
Metal Materials	Small appliances, metal flashing, metal furniture, household metals	Refrigerators, freezers, A/C units, any appliances with freon, lawn mowers
Household Waste	Household trash, furniture, linens, clothes. Televisions can be disposed of at the drop-off only, no pick-up.	Hazardous or bio-hazardous waste, needles, syringes, hot tubs, batteries.
Automotive	Bumpers, auto body panels, seats, upholstery	Tires, car/truck batteries, vehicle fluids, motor oil plastic bottles, windshield glass
